Conduct alleged to be sexual heasement will be evaluated by considering the totality of the particular circumstances, including the nature, frequency, intensity, location, context, and cluation of the questioned behavior. Repeated incidents or a pattern of heasesing behavior may be cause for serious connective action However; an one serious incident, even if is clated, may be sufficient cause for action under this policy including referral to lawer forcement when applicable

Based on the outcome of the investigation, the Title IX Officer or designee will determine if there is sufficient cause to proceed with the complaint. If the accused does not accept responsibility for the allegations and/or the proposed sanction (s), the Title IX Officer or designee will determine if the evidence variants a formal hearing before the Grievance Committee
